Ecuagold Resources Ltd. - Curiplaya Project Update

May 30, 2007 - Ecuagold Resources Ltd. (TSXV: EGR) updated the status of the company's Curiplaya Project, located in southern Ecuador.

The Phase I drilling program, planned for up to 5,000 metres of diamond core drilling, commenced on June 5, 2007. Two holes have been completed and samples were sent for assaying. Based on core logging, EGPU-01 intersected a 10 metre pyritic interval and EGPU-02 intersected a 20 metre pyritic interval.

Drilling of hole EGPU-04 in the Porotillos zone commenced on June 8, 2007. It was continued to a depth of 490 metres, the limit of the rig's capacity, and ended in mineralization.

Soil and grab rock sample geochemical assaying was also completed in the "Core Zone" stockwork target areas and a table of results can be found on the company's website. A total of 137 grab rock samples were taken in the "Core Zone." Sixteen trenches were completed and 223 channel samples were taken, with assays pending.

VDG del Peru SAC (VDG) completed an Induced Polarization ("IP") Survey in May 2007 over the entire exploration grid. VDG's report concluded that the resistivity patterns could be related to zones of alteration and sulphide mineralization surrounding the intrusive porphyries. Five main chargeability zones of interest were identified.

Ecuagold Resources Ltd. is engaged in the acquisition, exploration and potential development of primarily precious metals properties in Ecuador.

Radar Acquisitions Enters into LOI for Engineered Re-Fuel Technology

June 5, 2007 - Radar Acquisitions Corp. (TSXV: RAC; OTCBB: RDAQF), announced that Radar had signed an arm's length Letter of Intent with New Energy USA, LLC to explore the possibility of establishing a Joint Venture to utilize New Energy's Re-Fuel technology process to develop engineered solid fuel products using a combination of coal slurry pond waste and biomass. The Re-Fuel Technology is a patent pending process that utilizes a coal waste product and combines it with bio-mass to produce an engineered solid fuel product called Re-Fuel. The Re-Fuel technology has been licensed for use on three projects sites in the United States to date.

The LOI sets out terms whereby Radar, through ownership of 50 percent of the JV Entity, has an option to acquire a 50 percent interest in New Energy's four

proposed projects, as well as the option to participate in additional projects, for consideration of US\$1 million in common shares of Radar (at a deemed price of US\$0.25/share for an aggregate of four million Radar common shares), at which time the parties will enter into a Joint Venture and create a legal entity to develop, market and pursue the business of developing the Projects.

Mexican Silver Mines Ltd. to Complete \$10 Million Private Placement

June 4, 2007 - Mexican Silver Mines Ltd. (TSXV: MSM; Frankfurt: WKN A0MSLE; MS2) announced the trenching program at its 100%-owned La Blanca silver-lead-zinc project in Nuevo Leon, Mexico, has been completed and silver assays have been received. Five trenches were cut and sampled along the southern extension of the structure seen at the historic La Blanca mine workings.

The twenty eight samples taken returned silver values ranging from 897 grams per tonne (g/t) silver to 4,110 g/t silver. The average value for these 28 samples was 2,112 g/t silver. These very high grade results confirm previous sampling conducted on the project and present Mexican Silver with an immediate and intriguing drill target.

32 meters of 0.103% U308 Discovered in Third Phase Drilling at Two Time Zone

June 21, 2007 - Silver Spruce Resources Inc. (TSXV: SSE; Frankfurt: WKN A0JJTF; S6Q) announced results from a third phase of diamond drilling at the Two Time Zone.

The best mineralization, 109.2 m of 0.042% uranium oxide (U3O8) (0.84 lbs/ton) from 213.9 to 323.1 m, including 32 m at 0.103% U3O8 (2.06 lbs/ton) from 264.6 to 296.6 m, was located in DDH CMB-07-14 drilled on section 0+00.

The host for the mineralization is an altered, brecciated and fractured felsic intrusive, monzonite to monzodiorite, which carries extensive chlorite, carbonate and hematite alteration. The mineralized zone appears to be near vertical to steeply dipping indicating that drill intersections are probably one half to two thirds true width.

"We continue to be excited by these results," stated Lloyd Hillier, President and CEO of Silver Spruce. "The results indicate the strength of the uranium mineralized system and the potential for a major uranium deposit on the CMBNW property."

Scoping Study on Expanded Throughput Scenario Boosts Annual Cash Flow

June 28, 2007 - Crowflight Minerals Inc. (TSXV: CML; Frankfurt: WKN 358036; CMI) completed a scoping study to determine the parameters of an

expanded throughput scenario at the Bucko Lake Nickel Deposit currently under construction. It considered ramping-up production to up to 1,500 tpd commencing Q3-2009 (a 50% increase from the base case Bankable Feasibility Study level of production) and utilizing much of the same infrastructure and equipment as was considered in the initial scenario.

The additional capital cost to achieve this expansion is estimated at \$8.5 million and assuming US\$8.00 per pound nickel price (less than one-third the average price of nickel during 2007), average annual cash flow from the mine is boosted to \$78 million (a 42% increase) as compared to the base case BFS level of \$55.1 million.

Crowflight Minerals Inc. is currently focused on construction of the Bucko Lake Nickel Mine, which is scheduled to start production in Q2 2008.

Bonanza Intercept at Kay Tanda

June 15, 2007 - Mindoro Resources Ltd. (TSXV: MIO; Frankfurt: WKN 906167; OLM) intersected bonanza mineralization in core hole KTDH-20 at the Kay Tanda epithermal gold-silver prospect, Archangel Project, the Philippines. KTDH-20 intersected one meter of 12.92 g/t gold from 17 to 18 meters, and one meter of 246.41 g/t gold from 25 to 26 meters. This is part of an intersection grading 11.49 g/t gold over 25 meters from 3 to 28 meters. Results have not yet been received from below 28 meters. The mineralization is in classic epithermal hydrothermal breccias and stockworks and is considered to represent a true width intercept.

It is anticipated that more such bonanza zones will be encountered within the large area of mineralization outlined to date at Kay Tanda, where drilling has been mostly on 50 meter by 50 meter centers.

Mindoro Resources Ltd. is carrying out resource delineation at the Kay Tanda epithermal gold-silver

prospect and has identified 22 porphyry copper-gold prospects and a nickel laterite prospect in the Philippines.

GGL Receives Promising EM Data on Prospective Nickel Belt

June 14, 2007 - GGL Diamonds (TSXV: GGL) announced that a preliminary report on its nickel belt in the Northwest Territories identified additional electro-magnetic (EM) targets that may be associated with nickel mineralization.

The report, by Condor Consulting, Inc., covers the reassessment of Resolve™ frequency-domain EM surveys carried out on the Winter Lake and adjoining Zip project areas, located west of the Ekati Mine. The new work focused on extracting the most conductive features from the data and resulted in the identification of targets covering 32 km of strike length that may be associated with nickel mineralization.

Further work including ground checking is now in progress. This work is the first step in the exploration plans related to the recently announced discovery of nickel mineralization.

JV Partner Commences Drilling Muskox Nickel/Platinum Project, Nunavut

June 19, 2007 - Prize Mining Corporation (TSXV: PRZ; Frankfurt WKN A0D9T0; MQS1) announced its joint venture partner, Silvermet Inc., began the 2007 diamond drilling program at the company's Muskox project.

Drilling will test the extensive geochemical anomalies outlined by the 2006 exploration and sampling program. The project is being supervised by Dr. Larry Hulbert, one of Canada's foremost experts on the Muskox intrusion and nickel/PGM exploration.

Primary Metals Reports Improvements at Panasqueira Tungsten Mine

June 13, 2007 - Primary Metals Inc. (TSXV: PMI; Frankfurt: WKN A0BLR7; P5R) reported initial improvements at its Panasqueira tungsten mine resulting from the recent implementation of plans designed to increase the mine's profitability. May figures showed an overall increase in tungsten concentrate production resulting from a modest increase in the mined ore grade and slightly improved mining rates.

Tungsten production for the month increased 7.0% and the mined ore grade was higher, averaging

0.18% WO₃ (tungsten trioxide), an improvement over the low of 0.16% in February and the average of 0.17% for the prior four months. The mining rate was also slightly higher at 66,775 tonnes for the month compared to an average rate of 65,371 tonnes for prior months.

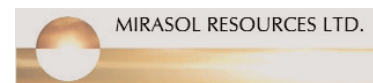

Mirasol Secures 100%-owned Copper-Gold Prospect in Northern Chile

June 12, 2007 - Mirasol Resources Ltd. (TSXV: MRZ; Frankfurt: WKN AOF4Z5; M8R) announced the acquisition of the Rubi copper-gold property, located on the prospective Paleocene-age porphyry and epithermal belt of Northern Chile.

The Paleocene metallogenic belt has a history of producing large copper porphyry and epithermal gold deposits exemplified by BHP Billiton's Spence project (3.5 Mt copper) and Meridian Gold's El Penon mine (3.8 M oz. gold; 63 M oz. silver).

The Rubi claims, covering 73 square kilometres, were staked as a result of the company's new Tertiary Generative Program. Completed reconnaissance exploration includes stream and rock geochemical sampling, regional mapping and PIMA analysis of the prospect area.

Great Quest Intersects Gold in Three More Drill Holes on Djambaye 2 Gold Zone

June 15, 2007 - Great Quest Metals Ltd. (TSXV: GQ; Frankfurt: WKN 657332; GQM) announced a fifth set of results from the 2007 diamond drill program on the Djambaye 2 gold zone, Kenieba concession, western Mali, West Africa. Golden Band Resources Starts Summer Exploration Program

June 18, 2007 - Golden Band Resources Inc. (TSXV: GBN) announced the start of its 2007 summer exploration programs at the Bingo and EP deposits.

This summer's fieldwork will consist of geological mapping and prospecting, bulk till sampling, soil gas hydrocarbon sampling, and diamond drilling.

In addition, a minimum of 3,000 metres of diamond drilling are planned.
